**Readings Next week (August 11, 2019) 19th Sunday**  
*Wisdom 18:6-9; Hebrews 11:1-2,8-19; Luke 12:32-48*  
**Background on the Gospel Reading**

Jesus' instructions on how to be ready for the coming judgment continue in the stories and sayings found in today's Gospel. We are not to be like the greedy rich man in last Sunday's Gospel who planned to store his great harvest in barns rather than share it. We are, rather, to share our wealth with those in need. The antidote for the anxiety brought on by the coming judgment is to relinquish our possessions and provide for the needs of others. Our treasure will be in heaven where it will not wear out or be destroyed. The other major way to be ready for the coming judgment is to be watchful. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about watchfulness to begin making this point. We must be like servants waiting for the master's return from a wedding banquet, which, even now, can last for a few days in the Middle East. We must be watchful so that even if the master comes after midnight, we will be ready for him. This is what the coming of the Son of Man will be like. Peter asks if this parable is meant for the apostles or for the large crowd that has gathered to listen to Jesus. Without answering Peter's question, Jesus responds with another parable about servants awaiting the return of their master. It begins with a question: "Who, then, is the faithful and prudent steward whom the master will put in charge of his servants to distribute the food allowance at the proper time?" This parable adds to the theme of watchfulness; it explains how to wait and reminds us of the reward for the faithful follower at the heavenly banquet after the judgment. If it is addressed to the apostles, then it could also be addressed to leadership in the early Church. Either way, the parables reminds us that we should be found doing our jobs when the master arrives. If we are doing our jobs, our reward will be great. But if we relax, neglect our duties, and begin to act like the greedy rich man—eating, drinking, and making merry—we will not have a place in the

kingdom. Watchfulness means living in such a consistently moral and obedient way that we are always ready to give an account to God of how we have lived.

**FEAST DAY OF ST JOHN VIANNEY AUGUST 04.** Priest of Ars France born at Dardilly, near Lyons France on May 8, 1786; died at Ars, August 4, 1859. He was the son of Mathieu Vianney and Marie Beluze, poor peasants with a strong faith. His childhood was marked by the tragic events of the French revolution. The priests and their faithful were hunted and sent to the guillotine. At this time Jean was studying catechism in secret and felt in love with Jesus. It was during a Mass celebrated secretly behind barred doors by an anti-revolution priest in a home near Ecully, close to his native parish, that Jean received his First Communion which strengthened him in his inmost desire. "I will be a priest", he affirmed. Overcoming enormous difficulties, he was ordained to the priesthood on August 13, 1815 in the chapel of the Seminary at Grenoble. From that time an adventure began for a tiny French town that down the centuries would never be forgotten: they were to receive their "Cure d' Ars". The pilgrimages to see him became international. 10,000 to 400,000 or perhaps even more pilgrims went every year to Ars. When the pilgrims left Ars, they were renewed. And all, like the peasant of Macon, who when asked, "But who did you see at Ars?" were able to reply: "I saw God, in a man." The greatest miracle of all was his life. He practiced mortification from his early youth and for forty years his food and sleep were insufficient, humanly speaking, to sustain life and yet he labored incessantly, with unflinching humility, gentleness, patience and cheerfulness, until he was more than seventy-three years old. Saint John Vianney remains to this day the living image of the priest after the heart of Christ. He died on August 4, 1859 and was canonized on May 31, 1925. On April 23, 1928 Pope Pius XI declared him Patron of the world's parish priests.

**CATECHISM IN A YEAR 46.** What did Jesus Christ reveal to us about the mystery of the Father? Jesus Christ revealed to us that God is "Father", not only insofar as he created the universe and the mankind, but above all because he eternally generated in his bosom the Son who is his Word, "the radiance of the glory of God and the very stamp of his nature." (*Hebrews 1:3*)

**47. Who is the Holy Spirit revealed to us by Jesus Christ?** The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Most Blessed Trinity. He is God, one and equal with the Father and the Son. He "proceeds from the Father" (*John 15:26*) who is the principle without a principle and the origin of all trinitarian life. He proceeds also from the Son (*Filioque*) by the eternal Gift which the Father makes of him to the Son. Sent by the Father and the Incarnate Son, the Holy Spirit guides the Church "to know all truth" (*John 16:3*).

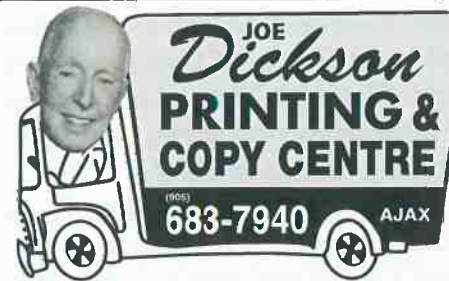
